

THE INTERNATIONAL TRAINING COURSE ON ENVIRONMENTAL HEAVY METALS - CONCEPT, POISON AND CONTROL

Due to rapid industrialization and urbanization, various pollutants caused by air pollution, land-based pollution and consumption of resources have seriously affected our environment quality. Heavy metal pollution is one of the very important environmental problems. The organizer from Institute of Mountain Hazards and Environment, Chinese Academy of Sciences will provide round way air tickets from trainee’s country to Chengdu (China) and from Chengdu back to the trainee’s country, accommodation and diets to all selected applicants during their stay for training.
